



How Do I Become an Entrepreneur?

Watch the *JA Our City* Lesson 3 volunteer video session. Then do this activity to think about a business you might own.

Materials

- Paper
- Crayons, markers, pens, and pencils

Activity

Check off the boxes as you finish your work.

- Divide a piece of paper into four sections.
- □ Label one PLACE, another PRODUCT, another PEOPLE, and the last one PROMOTION.
- □ Think about a business you might want to own someday—or a business you could have right now. It could be a pet store, your family's business, or a snack shop.
- □ In the PLACE square, draw a picture of your future business.
 - What will it look like?
 - How big will it be?
 - Will it be in a city or in the country?
- □ In the PRODUCT square, draw the things you would make or sell at your business.
- □ In the PEOPLE square, draw the people who will help in the business.
 - What kinds of jobs will need to be done?
 - What kinds of people will help do those jobs? An engineer? A seamstress? A computer programmer?
- □ In the PROMOTION square, draw how you will tell people about the business.
 - Will you have a big sign?
 - Will you make television commercials, create ads on social media, or place ads on the Internet?
 - Will you use posters or billboards?
- Share your completed future business plan with a friend or family member who owns a business. Talk with them about the choices they made when they became an entrepreneur.
